



At the heart of SAHAY's vision lies the passionate desire to invest in children and youth.

Since our early days, SAHAY has been developing ways to change the lives of young children and adolescents through high impact interventions in education, health & skills development.

In the last 35 years, we have initiated projects in several districts in the state of West Bengal, supporting tens of thousands of children and youth with our services and programmes.

SAHAY has always embraced a holistic development approach. SAHAY's multiyear support to children and youth involves a broad spectrum of activities, especially in the domains of healthcare, education, life skills development and livelihood support.



Our Thematic Priority: Education

EARLY CHILDHOOD CARE AND DEVELOPMENT

The Early Childhood Care and Development (ECCD) programme was initiated in 2022 with an integrated approach towards holistic learning experience and overall development of children in the 2-6 years age group.



One of the primary goals of the programme is to encourage caregivers to enroll their children in nearby Integrated Child development Scheme (ICDS) centres or pre-schools.

337 children were enrolled in the programme. The session plans were based on the government approved curriculum.

As the programme focuses on educating both, the child, and their caregivers; training sessions with parents were organized on nutrition, hygiene practices, and growth monitoring.



Training components included pre-school sessions for the children and awareness sessions for the mothers. Children received activity-based learning sessions to acquire skill sets on motor, cognitive,

and social-emotional aspects.

To increase outreach participants were provided with worksheets as doorstep intervention.

GROUP TUTORING PROGRAMME



1,662 beneficiaries have benefited through this intervention

Summer Learning Camp: A summer learning camp was held for **500** participants to bridge the learning gap. The camp included class-based worksheets, subject-specific activities, word games, riddles, and art.

The Group Tutoring programme provides tutoring support to sponsored children aiming to improve school retention and grade-specific learning.

In 2023, the Group Tutoring programme was designed to compensate the learning gap due to post effect of pandemic.

TUTORING PROGRAMME THROUGH COMMUNITY TEACHERS

In 2023, SAHAY had initiated a tutoring programme through community teachers. We have identified some of the best teachers in the community and have built a partnership with them for teaching the underprivileged children and youth.

E CAPSULE

We have piloted a technology-based, affordable e-learning and assessment platform for our children. All the course materials are in Bengali language. The mobile application-based learning modules bring the power of the digital world to the homes of the underprivileged children and youth participants of SAHAY's programmes.

The E Capsule programme provides independent tutoring support to youths, with the purpose of improving their grade-specific learning abilities.

- 100% enrollment and caregivers' orientation were done.
- 175 youths completed the sessions, and all have scored 85% and above in the assessments.



ACADEMIC GUIDANCE

Several academic guidance workshops for students who have passed/due to appear in 10th standard exams were conducted. The group workshops and the individual goal-setting exercises by experienced facilitators and life-skill trainers assisted the young students to select courses and subjects according to their individual aspirations, interests, talents and aptitude.

Our life skill trainers and social mobilisers facilitated these sessions. Moreover, experienced school teachers shared their knowledge and guidance regarding the professional opportunities available to the students in different academic disciplines

DIGITAL LITERACY

Digital skills allow children and adolescents to understand digital technologies and use the same technologies safely and ethically to search for educational information, and subsequently apply that information for their academic progress.

300 youths studying in grades 8 to 12 have benefited through SAHAY's Digital Literacy programme. The youths have received hands-on knowledge to enhance their digital skills. These youths can use the acquired knowledge in their academic and personal lives.





SCHOLARSHIPS

Our Scholarship programme aims to reduce the dropout rate among students and to motivate them to complete their education.

8,482 children and youths received scholarship support to complete their school education.

Our Youth Resource Centre (YRC) serves as a sanctuary and an educational hub for children and youth from financially stressed families. It offers a computer lab, counseling room, a games room, a conference room, training rooms, and a youth lounge.

Aflatoun (Social and Financial Education)

This programme aims to empower youths to become change agents in their communities and personal lives.

The programme covers personal exploration, child rights awareness, financial planning & financial literacy, budgeting and entrepreneurial skills

Emotional Wellbeing

The primary objective of the programme is to teach children in the 10-18 age group to cope with stress & psychological setbacks, increase adaptability to adverse situations and equip them with skills to develop a vision for their future.

Social and Financial Education

- 275 children and youths participated
- 99% participants improved their problem-solving skills
- The training helped them to develop self-awareness and social responsibility skills

Emotional Wellbeing

- 200 children & 100 caregivers participated
- 93% children & youth participants improved their emotional expressiveness

Our Thematic Priority: Employability

The Employability programme is divided into 3 major components- Post-Secondary Scholarships, Career Readiness and Into Employment.

The Employability Programme is designed for youths in the 19-24 years age group.

 326 youths received post-secondary scholarship support to pursue higher studies and technical education.

Some of our Scholars



- 75 youths have participated in the career readiness training. The Career Readiness component includes career counselling and training on problem-solving skills, negotiation skills, goal-setting, interview readiness & job search techniques, mock interviews and role-plays.
- 640 youths have participated in the Into Employment component provides domain-based skill development training, including mentorship, industrial exposure, computer skills and placement assistance to improve the employability quotient. 60% of the enrolled youth received job offers in 2023.
- 24 youths have received special scholarships to complete their professional education in FY 2023-24. Several underprivileged youths sponsored and supported by SAHAY have completed professional courses like Chartered Accountancy, Hospital Management, Hotel Management, B.Tech, MBBS, etc.



Connecting with Families

10,106 families received multiyear economic assistance during the COVID pandemic; the facility was extended till 2023



The Family Connect programme was started during the COVID pandemic to establish a connection with 10,000 families and to reassure them that SAHAY was attentive to their needs. The initiative was very well received, and the community's inputs were valued. SAHAY continued this programme till August 2023. As a part of this programme, SAHAY provided financial support to 10,106 families, comprising 15,142 children and youth.

SAHAY's sponsorship programme offers a vital opportunity for people and organisations to support our mission and amplify our impact. Sponsors contribute to the funding of vital programmes, materials and services that directly benefit the communities we serve. To ensure transparency and involvement, sponsors are provided with frequent updates on the status and impact of their donations.



Volunteers play a major role in the community as they act as the key contact between



SAHAY and the community. Our volunteers are integral to our organization, and their dedication and hard work have a significant impact on our success.

We have **267** volunteers supporting different activities of SAHAY. They help us organize community meetings, distribute articles, and even assist us to identify underprivileged children. Nearly 70% of our volunteers are mothers of sponsored children, and 10% are youth volunteers.


